

Presbytery Point Camp Summer Staff

Each summer, Presbytery Point Camp hires counselors, program and support staff to care for the needs of the campers during their week at camp. Potential staff members apply for a position, are interviewed by the camp manager, undergo a background and reference check and experience 1-1/2 weeks of intensive staff training to prepare them for the summer ahead. Staff members enjoy the bond that they develop with each other, as well as the relationships that they nurture with their campers. All staff live in residence at the camp and should be prepared to “live out of your suitcase” as housing location may change over the summer. In addition to salary, compensation includes room, board, and laundry facilities.

Volunteer adult support staff members and Youth Counselors/C.I.T.'s (must be at least 15 years old to assist counselors as well as help out with necessary duties around camp) are required to participate in training opportunities. Summer camp adult volunteers need to fill out a Volunteer Application, undergo background checks, and will then be signed up for appropriate training. To prepare C.I.T. volunteer youth for their amazing supporting role, leadership training is built in to our Senior High Camp week June 18-24, 2017..

Staff and Volunteer Applications will be reviewed as received. Interviews will be scheduled, and positions filled beginning in February 2017. Submit application and reference letters as soon as able for best consideration.

Counselors must be at least 19 years old to work and are directly assigned to cabin groups during the weeks of camp. They are with their campers day and night taking care of their needs and guiding them throughout their camp adventure. Campers develop a strong bond with their counselors, as counselors can make such a positive impact in their lives. Counselors lead and participate with their groups in Bible Studies and camp activities. Being a camp counselor is an amazing responsibility! This sometimes difficult, but mostly fun and exhilarating, experience can change your life. All staff members play supporting roles and backup each other's duties in case of illness, camp census, or other immediate need. Other staff positions have age requirements. Please check job descriptions for complete information.

The summer for staff begins with staff training May 30th, and the season ends after camps and clean-up August 23rd. Some staff positions season vary. Check with the camp manager for more information.
